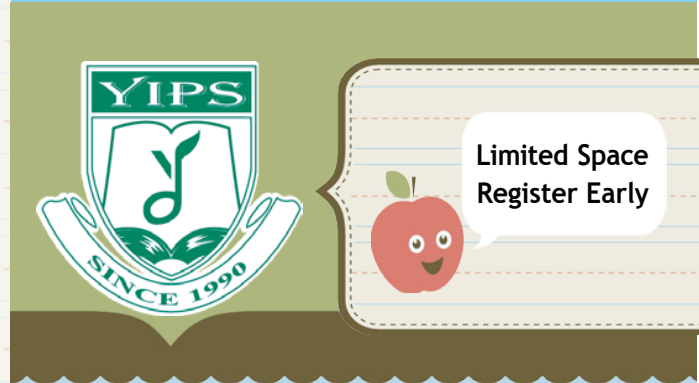
Yip's Chamber Orchestra

REGULATIONS

- The school reserves the right to alter the class schedule or cancel any class; parents will be notified of any changes.
- Lunch fee is \$6 per meal (order by week). Snacks are included.
- Special arrangements for additional hours: arriving between 7:00 to 8:45 am and / or leaving between 4:15 to 6:30 pm can be arranged with the office. Students will be charged at \$6 per session. \$6 per 15 minutes and \$1 per minute after 6:30 pm will be charged for late pick up.
- No class changes will be allowed after the first day of each term unless approved by the school.
- Fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable for sickness or any other reasons; unless classes are canceled by the school.
- Field trips will be arranged in Term 2 and Term 4. Notice will be sent out 1 week in advance. No theme program arranged on that day.
- A material fee \$6 (HD) / \$10 (FD) per week will apply to all terms (except Strings Camp). Materials include folder, stationery, baking and art/crafts media. Instrument rental fee \$50 will apply to Chinese Music Program. Students will be responsible for instrument's damage cost.
